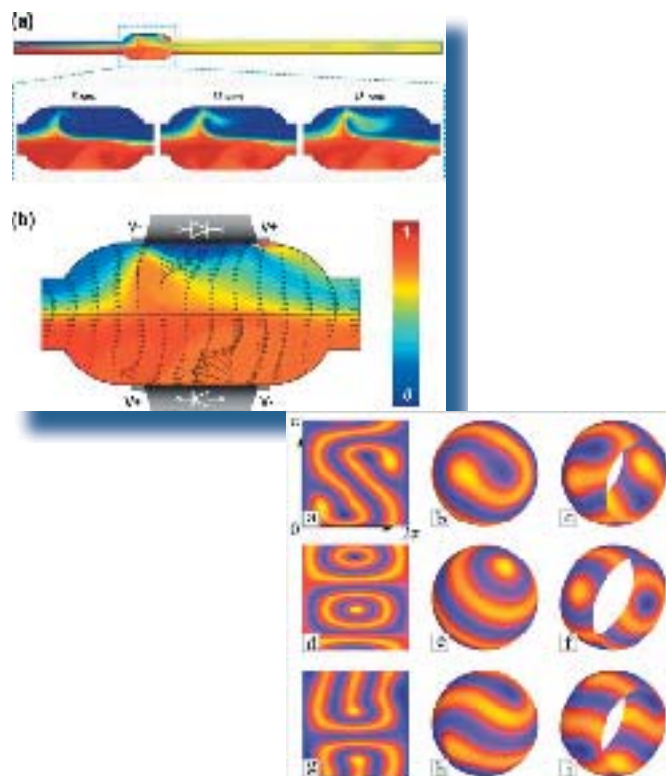
**Carlos Garcia-Cervera**, Associate Professor of Mathematics
